- Michele Stein opened the meeting in prayer
- Childcare was provided for the meeting by the HS Youth Group.
- Treasurer Report:
 - Jogathon money was transferred back to the General Fund
 - \$400 will be transferred from School Store to General Fund (this is half of the start up money; the rest will be paid back in Jan.)
 - Swings, scooters and rolling cart have been purchased; they will be reimbursed out of that fund soon.
- Etsy Report: the website is up and running! Donations are still being sought and will be added periodically. If anyone has something to donate or knows someone who crafts, please contact Kristin Huber.
- Eagles Nest: Stephanie reported that the pizza sales have gone well.
 - Starting this week, the pizza will be Smart Slice, which offers whole grain crust, low sodium sauce, and low fat cheese and pepperoni. Slices will be larger and cost the same!
 - Prepaid pizza cards are available in the school office.
 - New items are coming in regularly

 - Families in need: in the past week, two more families have approached Michele about tuition assistance. We are now at a point where half of the families at FCS are receiving some kind of assistance.

- Facebook and photosharing: we are waiting to establish a Facebook presence until school guidelines and procedures are established. The reason is that we want to protect the release of photos and identifiable information for FCS students.
